


Information about processing of personal data

1. ČZ a.s., having its headquarters at Sluneční náměstí 2540/5, Praha 5, Id. No.: 25181432, registered in the Trade register kept by District Court in Prague, Section B, File No. 9762 (“**Administrator**”), organizes an event on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of establishing of company ČZ called “Celebration of the 100th anniversary of establishing ČZ” on September 14th, 2019. The event will take place at the production site in Strakonice and at its parking area. Programme of the event is available on the website www.czas.cz, in the posters and in the newspapers. Throughout the actions related to this event, ČZ a.s. will processes the personal data of the natural persons, who will take part in the event (“**data subjects**”). The data subjects may contact the Administrator via email address jpenkava@czas.cz in matters concerning the processing of personal data.
2. The Administrator will process the identification and contact data of data subjects – name, surname, address, phone/cell phone, email, passenger’s name and surname. The data will be filled by participant, application form will be sent to organizing committee, thus these data will be collected by the Administrator during the performance of a contract (“**Agreement**”).
3. The Administrator processes the personal data of data subjects for the performance of the contract, pursuant to Art. 6 paragraph 1 b) of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council No. 2016/679 issued on 27. 4. 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive No. 95/46/ES (“**GDPR**”);
4. Personal data will be processed no longer than necessary, thus until the end of the abovementioned event.
5. The personal data will be destroyed (shredding or any other appropriate manner which shall ensure that unauthorized person will not be able to get them) or anonymized till the end of calendar quarter following the day in which their processing has expired according to Art. 4
6. The Administrator has the right to submit the personal data to the third party – co-organizing club Veteran Cluc Strakonice (VCC Strakonice). Other recipients are allowed only if they are specified by law.
7. Concerning the processing of personal data, the data subjects have a number of rights, including the right of access by the data subject (upon conditions stipulated in Art. 15 GDPR), rectification or erasure of personal data (upon conditions stipulated in Art. 16 or Art. 17 GDPR), right to restriction of processing (upon conditions stipulated in Art. 18 GDPR), and right to object (upon conditions stipulated in Art. 21 GDPR), as well the right to data portability (upon conditions stipulated in Art. 20 GDPR).
8. Where the data subject is of the opinion that the processing of his/her personal data does not comply with legal requirements, he/she has the right to appeal the Administrator to adopt corrective actions. Where such request is found as legitimate, the Administrator shall immediately take a corrective action. This does not exclude an opportunity of data subjects to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (The Office for Personal Data Protection).
